**All supporting documents such as transcripts and test scores must be postmarked by February 15 to receive full consideration. Applicants whose documents are submitted after that date will be considered on a space available basis.

Applying for admission

1. Application and fee: Complete the application form and send it to the Office of Admissions with a \$65 (U.S. dollars) non-refundable fee.

2. Educational credentials: Submit official transcripts for all secondary or high schools, colleges, and universities you have attended. Official copies are issued directly by your school, college, or university in a sealed envelope and must bear the official stamp or seal of the institution as well as the signature of the appropriate official. If your transcripts are not in English, send a copy in the original language and provide a certified translation in an envelope sealed by the certified translator. Facsimile or electronic mail transmissions of transcripts will not be accepted.

If your institution or country issues only one original transcript, contact the Office of Admissions *before* submitting your transcript to prevent your original from being destroyed.

You may receive college credit for Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) A Level, or other advanced level examinations. Official results must be submitted to receive credit.

3. English language proficiency: In order to be considered for admission, you must demonstrate your proficiency in English with a minimum score from one of the following tests. Meeting these score requirements does not guarantee admission.

4. SAT and ACT scores: Not required for international students, with the exception of architecture and honors college applicants. However, SAT or ACT results can increase your chance of admission and make you eligible for additional scholarships.

5. Personal statement and letters of recommendation (optional): If your academic performance was affected by special circumstances, you may submit a personal statement and explanation.

6. Passport: A copy of your passport is strongly encouraged to ensure the fastest processing of your application.

Housing

Apply for housing as soon as you are admitted to the UO. Housing is limited, and is awarded on a first-come basis. Make your initial housing payment and sign your residence hall contract, all online. This process will secure your space in the halls, so please complete it as soon as possible after you are admitted. For more information, visit housing.uoregon.edu.

Conditional admission

If you meet all university requirements except for the English Language Proficiency requirement, you may be conditionally admitted to the university and must enroll in the American English Institute (AEI) aei.uoregon.edu. Upon successful completion of the highest level of English instruction at AEI, you will be granted full admission to the UO. While studying at studying at AEI, you may submit a valid passing TOEFL score to be considered for full admission to the UO.

Immigration

Information provided on this application must match your passport. To prepare your immigration documents, US immigration regulations require documentation of financial support for you and dependents who will accompany you to the United States. Financial documents must be dated within six months of applying and can include bank statements, certificates of balance, sponsor letters, certificates of deposit, or scholarship letters. Mail or fax your financial documents as soon as possible.

Admission deferral

Applications are processed for the term specified on your application. To apply for a different term, you must submit a new application and updated transcripts. The \$65 application fee is good for one academic year (September through July).
