

2016–17 INTERNATIONAL POSTBACCALAUREATE UNDERGRADUATE APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Applying for admission

1. Application and fee: Complete the application form and send it to the Office of Admissions with a \$65 (U.S. dollars) nonrefundable fee.

2. Educational credentials: Submit official transcripts for all secondary or high schools, colleges, and universities you have attended. Official copies must be issued directly by your school, college, or university in a sealed envelope and must bear the official stamp or seal of the institution as well as the signature of the appropriate official. If your transcripts are not in English, send a copy in the original language and provide a certified translation in an envelope sealed by the certified translator. Facsimile or electronic mail transmissions of transcripts will not be accepted.

If your institution or country issues only one original transcript, contact the Office of Admissions before submitting your transcript to prevent your original from being destroyed.

3. Statement of purpose: In addition to the documents listed above, you must submit a statement of purpose—a one-page explanation of the reasons you want to pursue a second bachelor's degree.

4. English language proficiency: In order to be considered for admission, you must demonstrate your proficiency in English with a minimum score from one of the following tests. Meeting these score requirements does not guarantee admission.

Paper-based Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)	500
Internet-based TOEFL.	61
International English Language Testing System (IELTS)	6.0

5. Passport: A copy of your passport is strongly encouraged to ensure the fastest processing of your application.

6. Special studies major: If you plan to major in architecture, interior architecture, landscape architecture, educational foundations, family and human services, or international studies, contact the academic department for pre-approval prior to applying for admission. If you plan to major in business administration, communication disorders and sciences, fine and applied arts, or music, submit your application for admission and the Office of Admissions will then contact the academic department for departmental approval.

7. Application deadlines: This completed application and supporting documents must be submitted no fewer than 30 days before the beginning of the term in which you are applying for admission.

Conditional admission

If you meet all university requirements except for the English language proficiency requirement, you may be conditionally admitted to the university. If admitted, you must enroll in the American English Institute (AEI), aei.uoregon.edu. Upon successful completion of the highest level of English instruction at AEI, you will be granted full admission to the UO. While studying at AEI, you may submit a valid passing TOEFL score to be considered for full admission to the UO.

Immigration

Information provided on this application must match your passport. To prepare your immigration documents, U.S. immigration regulations require documentation of financial support for you and your dependents who will stay with you in the United States. Financial documents must be dated within six months of applying and can include bank statements, certificates of balance, sponsor letters, certificates of deposit, or scholarship letters. Please mail, e-mail, or fax your financial documents as soon as possible.

Admission deferral

Applications are processed for the term specified on your application. To apply for a different term, you must submit a new application and updated transcripts. The \$65 application fee is good for one academic year (September through July).

Housing

Apply for housing as soon as you are admitted to the UO. Housing is limited and is awarded on a first-come basis. Make your initial housing payment and sign your residence hall contract, all online. This process will secure your space in the halls, so please complete it as soon as possible after you are admitted. For more information visit housing.uoregon.edu.
