Applying for admission

- 1. Application and fee: Complete the application form and send it to the Office of Admissions with a \$75 (U.S. dollars) non-refundable fee.
2. Educational credentials: Submit official transcripts for all secondary or high schools, colleges, and universities you have attended.
3. English language proficiency: In order to be considered for admission, you must demonstrate your proficiency in English with a minimum score from one of the following tests.
Test Passing score
Paper-based Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) 500
Internet-based TOEFL 61
International English Language Testing System (IELTS) 6.0

- 4. SAT and ACT scores: Not required for international students, with the exception of architecture and honors college applicants.
5. Personal statement and letters of recommendation (optional): If your academic performance was affected by special circumstances, you may submit a personal statement and explanation.
6. Passport: A copy of your passport is strongly encouraged to ensure the fastest processing of your application.

Housing

Apply for housing as soon as you are admitted to the UO. Housing is limited, and is awarded on a first-come basis. Make your initial housing payment and sign your residence hall contract, all online. Conditional admission

If you meet all university requirements except for the English Language Proficiency requirement, you will be conditionally admitted to the university and must enroll in the American English Institute (AEI) aei.uoregon.edu. Upon successful completion of the highest level of English instruction at AEI, you will be granted full admission to the UO. While studying at AEI, you may also submit a valid qualifying TOEFL score to be considered for full admission to the UO.

Immigration

Information provided on this application must match your passport. To prepare your immigration documents, US immigration regulations require documentation of financial support for you and dependents who will accompany you to the United States. Financial documents must be dated within six months of applying and can include bank statements, certificates of balance, sponsor letters, certificates of deposit, or scholarship letters. Mail or fax your financial documents as soon as possible.

Admission deferral

Applications are processed for the term specified on your application. To apply for a different term, you must submit a new application and updated transcripts. The \$75 application fee is good for one academic year (September through July).
