International Freshman and Transfer Application Deadlines

Applications received after the postmark deadlines below are considered on a space-available basis.

Admission deadlines

Table with admission deadlines: Fall 2019 (Early Action, Regular), Winter 2020, Spring 2020, Summer 2020, and Scholarship deadlines.

**All supporting documents such as transcripts and test scores must be postmarked by February 15 to receive full consideration. Applicants whose documents are submitted after that date will be considered on a space available basis.

Departmental application deadlines

Table with departmental application deadlines: Architecture, Art, Art and Technology, Interior Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Product Design, Clark Honors College, Music.

Applying for admission

1. Application and fee: Complete the application form and send it to the Office of Admissions with a \$75 (U.S. dollars) non-refundable fee.

2. Educational credentials: Submit official transcripts for all secondary or high schools, colleges, and universities you have attended.

If your institution or country issues only one original transcript, contact the Office of Admissions before submitting your transcript to prevent your original from being destroyed.

You may receive college credit for Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) A Level, or other advanced level examinations.

3. English language proficiency: In order to be considered for admission, you must demonstrate your proficiency in English with a minimum score from one of the following tests.

Table with English language proficiency tests and passing scores: TOEFL (500), Internet-based TOEFL (61), IELTS (6.0).

4. SAT and ACT scores: Not required for international students, with the exception of architecture and honors college applicants.

5. Personal statement and letters of recommendation (optional): If your academic performance was affected by special circumstances, you may submit a personal statement and explanation.

6. Passport: A copy of your passport is strongly encouraged to ensure the fastest processing of your application.

Housing

Apply for housing as soon as you are admitted to the UO. Housing is limited, and is awarded on a first-come basis.

Conditional admission

If you meet all university requirements except for the English Language Proficiency requirement, you will be conditionally admitted to the university and must enroll in the American English Institute (AEI).

Immigration

Information provided on this application must match your passport. To prepare your immigration documents, US immigration regulations require documentation of financial support for you and dependents.

Admission deferral

Applications are processed for the term specified on your application. To apply for a different term, you must submit a new application and updated transcripts.
